"It was good to stop and focus on our relationship. As we learned to share feelings, I think it will have a freeing affect on our relationship and on each of us individually."

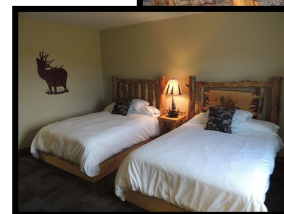

Misconceptions about Marriage Encounter

Only couples who are struggling or have bad marriages attend Marriage Encounter Weekends.

While some couples with struggling marriages do attend, Marriage Encounter focuses on making good marriages GREAT. Our goal is to enable couples to strengthen their relationship with God and their spouse.

Marriage Encounter is geared toward women and their feelings.

This weekend is mutually beneficial to both spouses. Many men are amazed by how much they learned and grow from experiences on the weekend. One husband said, "I realized that it is ok to be vulnerable and open with my wife and my confidence in our relationship grew much stronger."

You will have to participate in group sharing on the Marriage Encounter Weekend.

This weekend is about you and your spouse. It is a time to focus on your marriage without daily distractions. While the couples presenting the weekend share personal stories with you, your journey will remain private between you and your spouse. Any sharing is completely voluntary.

Marriage Encounter isn't about fixing spouses or pointing fingers. It is a personal and positive experience offering married couples an opportunity to learn tools that they will use for the rest of their lives. It's not a retreat, marriage clinic, group sensitivity, or a substitute for counseling. It is a unique approach aimed at revitalizing marriages.
